Overview

Research and Consultancy (R&C), M.I.T., Manipal in association with IEEE Mangalore Sub-Section is organizing a one day workshop on inculcating the research culture among UG B.Tech Students. In addition to the technical knowledge acquired during graduation, they are in need of proper orientation towards research. This workshop aims to encourage budding researchers towards research and innovation. The event includes expert lectures on how to carry out the research systematically, how to write the research papers and to disseminate them in a right publication. The Students from Computer Science stream (CSE, ISE, IT) and Electrical stream (E&E, E&C.....) are encouraged to participate. The resource persons for this workshop are experts from Academia and Industry. The workshop will be conducted in two sessions.

Session 1: This session consists of three lectures by eminent speakers. The students will learn the technique of writing a research article.

Mode of hands on in the afternoon session

1. The registered participants will be given the topics in the following areas under each discipline.
 - **Computer Science Stream:** Database Systems, Computer Vision, Software Engineering.
 - **Electrical stream:** VLSI, Signal Processing, Communication.
2. Based on their interest and their reply, the student will be provided five research articles via e-mail.
3. From these five articles, the student has to prepare (by typing in the afternoon session) the research article (1-2 pages) from his/her perspective using the techniques learnt in the morning session and should save their MS word file with the file name IEEE_Workshop_ParticipantNameWithInitial.docx.
4. These files will be checked for plagiarism and will be evaluated further by the panel.
5. As a feedback, the paper along with the plagiarism report will be e-mailed to each participant after evaluation.
6. The evaluation result will be announced on Oct 1st in www.ieee-mangalore.org and the winners will be awarded on IEEE day (Oct 3rd, 2017).

Reward and recognition

Three cash prizes and certificate will be rewarded to the winners and participation certificate to attendees.

1st Place: 5000 INR, **2nd Place:** 3000 INR, and **3rd Place:** 2000 INR.
